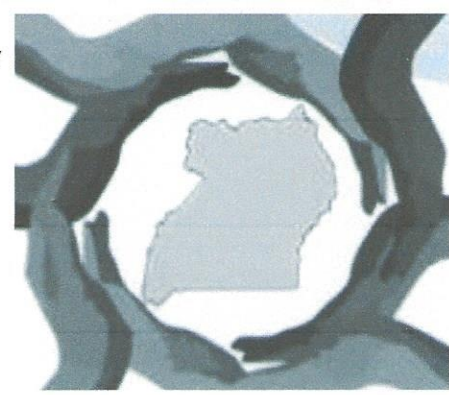


NORTHER UGANDA SELF SUFFICIENCY

Such is the story in the village of Acholinyek. It is an isolated war zone village and far away from access points. Expected facilities for medical care, education, markets, and nutritional food are nonexistent. The Orthodox Church now finds Herself in this area and called to respond to these many needs.

This hard-working village is not seeking hand-outs.

They desire the tools with which they can "Do it!"

NUSSP is introducing hope for the possibility of *self-sufficiency* in all of the areas necessary for this community to move forward with a sense of well-being.

Acholinyek has no health facility to respond to major and common illness like malaria yet the area has no access road to travel elsewhere.

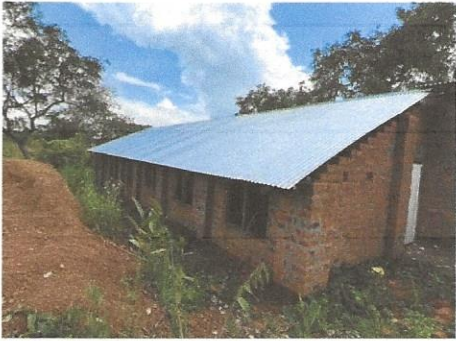
In June, we built a medical clinic.

And what about the piglets?! Their home is almost ready!



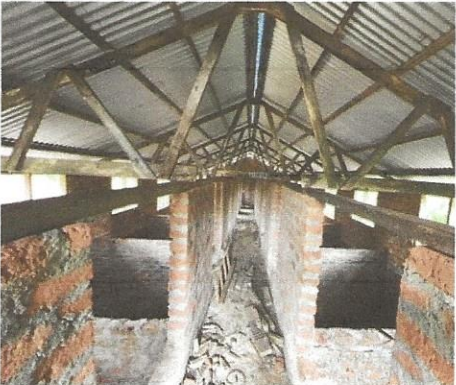
Much progress has been made. The roof, windows, and doors are in place. It's beautiful! And now, it is time for food and water supply, tools and ... piglets!
